

# A Cereal Pendant

1. Cut an orange fish for each child from paper. Punch a hole where “x” marks the spot. Print these words on the fish, “Jesus helps (child’s name).”
2. FOR FUN: Make this activity a *Bible Surprise*. Hide the fish in the Bible beforehand. “Let’s see who Jesus can help.” Find the fish one at a time and read the words.
3. Have ready a length of yarn which has had the tip stiffened with glue and dried overnight.  
This should be long enough to go around a child’s neck and tie in a bow.
4. Use round cereal with holes, such as Cheerios, to string on to the yarn. Have plenty of extra cereal for nibbling.

When the child hears his or her own name, the Bible seems more personal and its message that Jesus is our Helper becomes much more meaningful.

Let the children string the cereal on half of the yarn. After you reach the halfway mark, thread through the hole in the fish, and finish stringing cereal on the other half.
